#### 3. Update and Discussion: Safe Passage Park

- H. Franks shares updates on Safe Passage Park, new community space running along the South side of the 200 block of Turk St. Grand Opening set for Saturday, July 17th.
- S. McKinnon shares idea for hanging gardens/plants running up the vertical elements of the space.

## 4. Update and Discussion: Dodge Alley

- H. Franks gives updates on Dodge Alley, efforts to activate the space and build a gate.
- S.McKinnon asks how we make sure the space remains active and doesn't become a space like McCoppin Hub or Tenderloin National Forest that were alleyways/spaces converted into public space that are no longer very active.
- H. Franks agrees that ongoing activation is crucial. Hopes that Block Safety Groups can support the activations long-term.
- N. Maisel shares idea we could unite these different new public spaces with marketing/language that unites spaces, a medallion or something that we could add to spaces. This could tie into a larger Inviting Space branding campaign.
